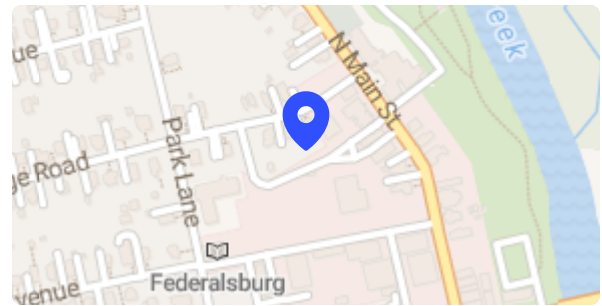
Thelma I. Mills of Federalsburg died at Nanticoke Hospital in Seaford, DE on Friday, July 12, 2013. She was 71.

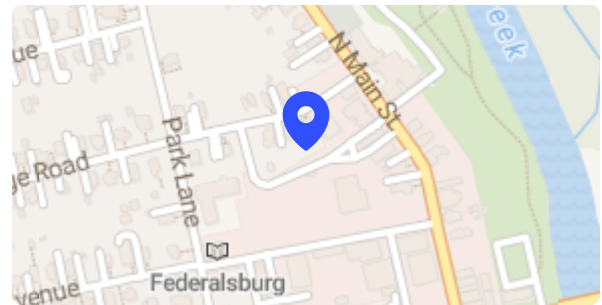

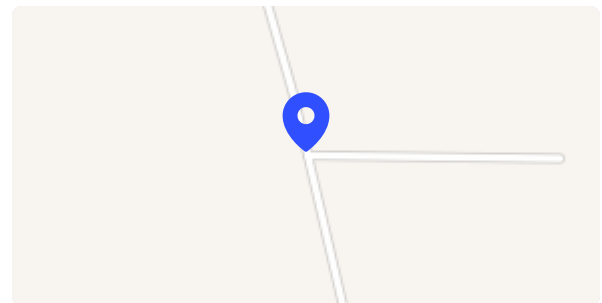
