Dawson H. Anthony died at his home in Federalsburg on Sunday, Sept. 22, 2013. He was 82.

He was born in Greensboro, MD on January 30, 1931 the son of the late William Anthony and Susie Flowers Anthony. He was a graduate of Greensboro High School and then entered the U S Air Force during the Korean War. On July 16, 1952 he married the former Betty Hackett. He worked for Federalsburg Fuel Express, the former Ruf's Liquors, Caroline Poultry, and also drove a school bus in the Federalsburg district for many years. He was a life member of Federalsburg Volunteer Fire Company, past Commander of Federalsburg V F W Post #5246, served on the Town Council of Federalsburg and was a member of American Legion.
