Katie E. Crandell, 81, of Federalsburg, MD passed away on Saturday October 19, 2013 at Atlantic General Hospital in Berlin, Maryland. She was 81.

She was born in Cambridge, MD on December 28, 1931 to the late Robert L. And Della Wroten Elzey, one of fourteen children.

On July 20, 1953 she married the late Adelbert F. "Wes" Crandell who passed away on May 31, 1991.

She was a member of Calvary Baptist Church in Denton for more than 35 years. She taught Sunday School, hosted and directed with many church dinners and served in the children's ministry watching children.

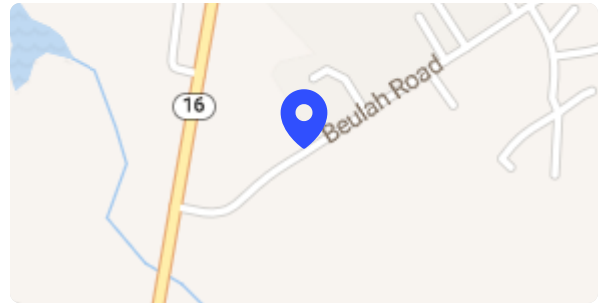
