She later attended Greenwood School No. 222C and Phillis Wheatley School in Bridgeville, DE.

She married the late Preston Howard Hayes, Sr. and from that union six children were born. She also helped raise many foster children in her home.

For years she was a line worker at Dulany Food Processing. Later, she was employed in food service at Dillard's Restaurant, Greenwood County Rest Home, Seaford Manor House and Milford School District Cafeteria.

Mrs. Hayes was a member of Williams Chapel Church in Bridgeville under the pastorship of her cousin the late Rev. Charles DeShields. She was on the usher board until her health began to fail. She was also a member of the Bridgeville Home Demonstration Club, the Bridgeville Senior Center and assistant leader of the Greenwood Helping Hands 4H Club. She enjoyed sewing and needle craft.
