The family has suggested memorial contributions be made to the Framptom Funeral Home, 216 North Main Street Federalsburg, MD 21632 to help defray funeral costs






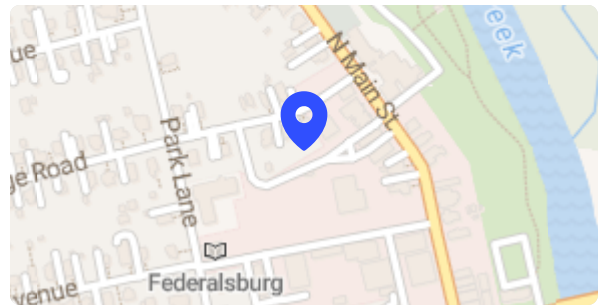

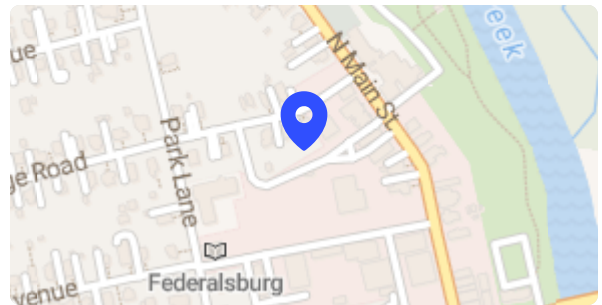

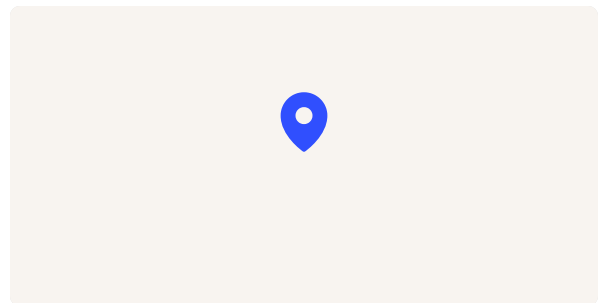
