Betsy Watkins Sterling of Snow Hill, Maryland passed away at Berlin Nursing Home on Wednesday, May 21, 2014. She was 90.

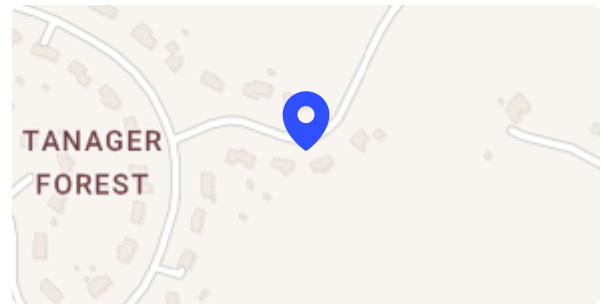
