Janet L. Blades of Federalsburg passed away surrounded by her family on Sunday, January 11, 2015 at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital in Seaford, Delaware. She was 67.

She was born on October 29, 1947 in Baltimore, Maryland, the daughter of the late Henry Alfred Hiltz and Mary James Hiltz.

She graduated from Dundalk High School in 1965. She married Thomas Blades on April 12, 1970. She worked as a bookkeeper for many years for Esskay, and later for Wheatley Trucking. She enjoyed volunteering at the First Church of God where she served as treasurer, taught Vacation Bible School, crafts, and helped in the kitchen. 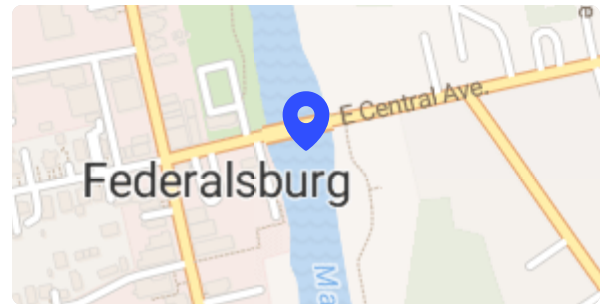

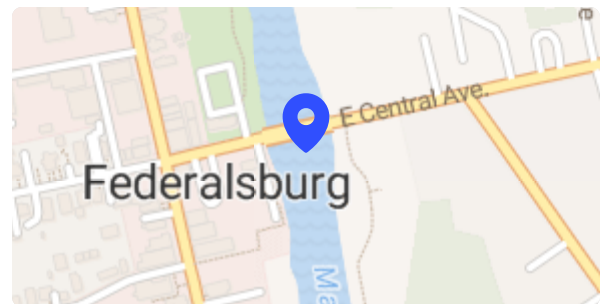

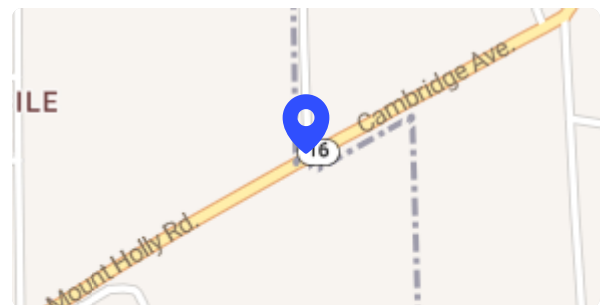
