She was a member of Park Lane Church of God in Federalsburg where she taught Sunday School.

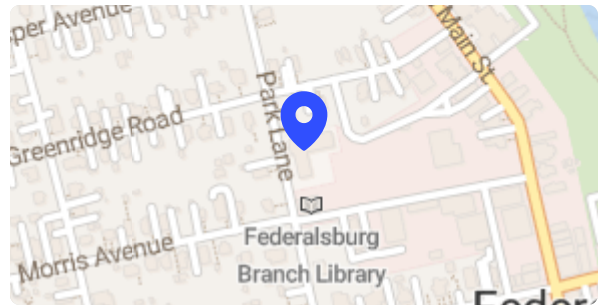

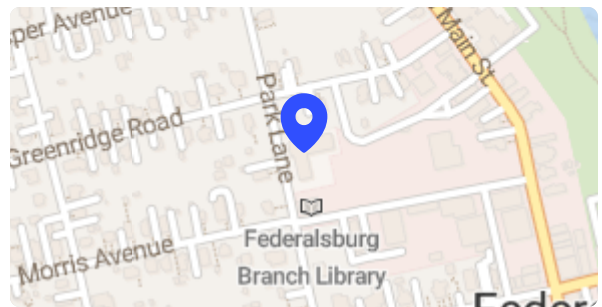

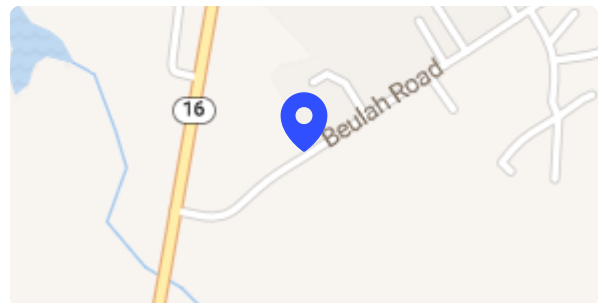
