Thomas E. Hambleton Bozman, Thomas E. Hambleton, of Bozman, died at the U.M.S.M.C. Easton, on Friday July 15, 2016. He was 75. Born in Easton, MD; on November 14, 1940 he was the son of the late Horace and Lois Reed Hambleton. He graduated from St. Michaels High School in 1958, then began a life-long career as a commercial waterman. On April 7, 1961 he married Mary Ann Billingham, they made their home in Bozman. Tommy retired in 2003 due to health reasons. In addition to his beloved wife Mary Ann, he is survived by his son; Thomas E.
