## Marie Quidas Watts

MAY 27, 1914 - FEB 3, 2007

**M**arie Quidas Watts, formerly of Philadelphia, PA, passed away on Saturday, Feb. 3, 2007 at Caroline Home for Hospice in Denton, MD. She was 92 years old.

She was born May 27, 1914 on the Wings Landing Farm in Preston, the daughter of the late Fredrick and Fannie Worm Quidas. Her husband of 69 years, Lloyd Hilton Watts, Sr. preceded her in death.

She was a homemaker and had worked as a clerk at Rodgers Market in Philadelphia for 10 years. In her younger days she was active in the Caroline County 4-H, was baptized in the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Preston, and a member of the Homemaker's Club.
