## **Elmer Jester**

**E**lmer F. Jester, Jr. of Federalsburg, MD passed away on Friday, Dec. 28, 2007 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD. He was 61 years old.

He was born Nov. 10, 1946 in Easton, MD, the son of the late Elmer J. Jester, Sr. and Mary Jane Lane Jester.

He was a graduate of Colonel Richardson High School class of 1966. He served his country in the U.S. Army from 1966 to 1969 serving one tour in Viet Nam. He worked at Southern States in Seaford, DE for 15 years, and was presently employed at David A. Bramble, Inc. as a truck driver. He was a life member of the Federalsburg Volunteer Fire Co. joining in December of 1978, and loved fishing, hunting and Nascar events.


He is survived by his wife, Karen A. Breeding Jester, a daughter and her husband, Kimberly D. Moore and Darrin of Preston, two special grandchildren, Conner Moore and Kaylie Moore of Preston, and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a sister, Rebecca Collins and a brother Charles Wade Jester, Sr.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, Jan. 3, 2008 at 1:00 p.m. at the Framptom Funeral Home in Federalsburg with Rev. Denzil Cheek officiating. Interment with military honors will follow at the Eastern Shore Veterans Cemetery in Beulah. 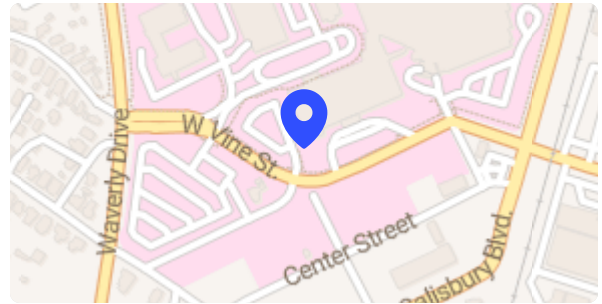

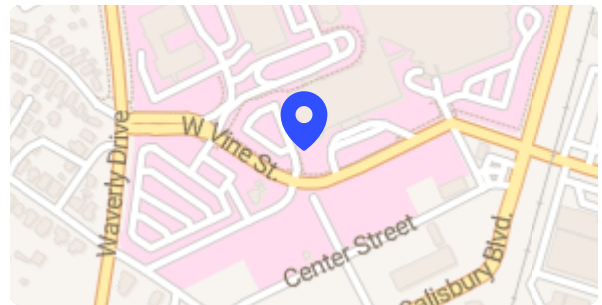
