# Jerome Hubert Wells

MAR 25, 1949 - JUL 27, 2008

**J**erome Hubert “Jerry” Wells of Seaford, DE passed away on Sunday, July 27, 2008 at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital in Seaford, DE. He was 59 years old.

He was born March 25, 1949 in Salisbury, MD, the son of Betty Bennett Wells Roden of Galestown, MD, and the late Hubert G. Wells.

He was a graduate of North Dorchester High School class of 1967. He worked as a tow cutter for E.I. DuPont. He loved to hunt and work in taxidermy. He was an avid fan of the Washington Redskins and the Baltimore Orioles.
