Etta Mae Andrew of Federalsburg, MD passed away on Thursday, November 6, 2008 at her residence. She was 83 years old.

Born in Cambridge, MD on May 29, 1925 she was the daughter of the late Melville F. and Marie A. Gallagher Hubbard. Her husband, G. Thomas Andrew preceded her in death on Dec. 7, 2006.

She was a graduate of Federalsburg High School Class of 1942. Since her senior year of high school she taught piano and organ lessons. 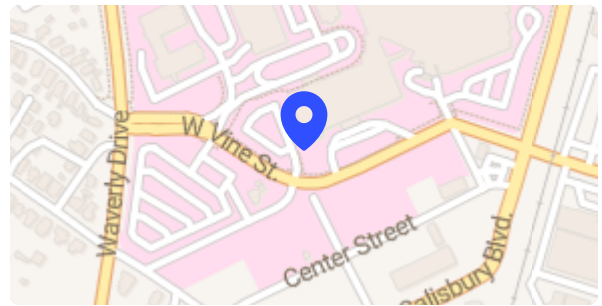
