Mary Audrey "Moggy" Hooper of Federalsburg, passed away at her home on Mon., Feb. 2, 2009. She was 92 years old.

She was born March 15, 1916 in Ellwood, near Preston, MD the daughter of the late Edward and Augusta Smith Crumble. Her husband, William E. "Biggie" Hooper preceded her in death on July 24, 1995.

She helped her husband in farming and was a homemaker. For over 50 years she attended the Church of God of Prophecy in Federalsburg and was held in high esteem as Church Mother.

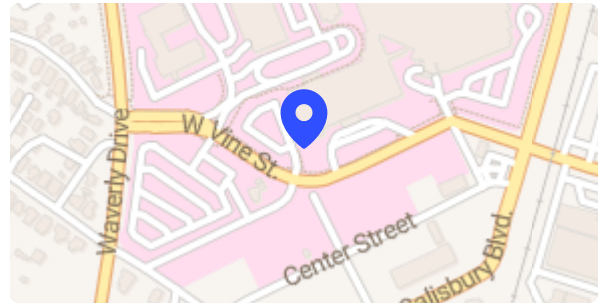

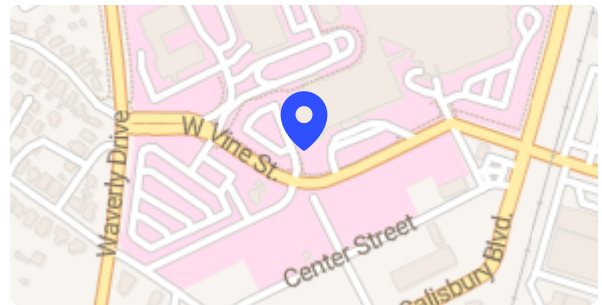
