Percy Lee Sample of Cambridge, MD passed away on Wednesday, July 1, 2009 at his home. He was 61 years old.

Percy was born Aug. 19, 1947 in Federalsburg, MD the son of the late Ernest and Maggie Mapp Sample.

He was a graduate of Mace's Lane Class of 1965. He served his country in the United States Army and was a veteran of the Vietnam War. He had worked for the former Zaffree's Bakery for ten years, and had also been employed by Acme Markets as a cashier and porter for over 17 years.

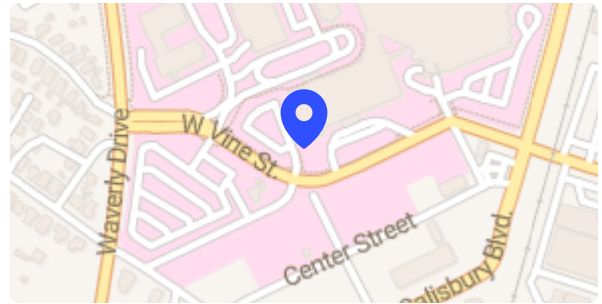

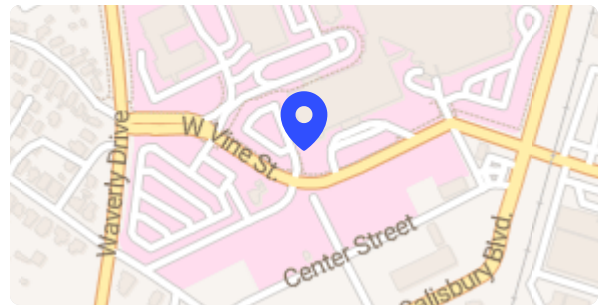
