Sampson Benjamin "Ben" Feyl, Jr. died at his home near Bridgeville, DE on Thursday, October 22, 2009. He was 65.

He was born in Hartley, DE on December 20, 1943 the son of the late Sampson B. Feyl, Sr and Olive Marie Tingle Feyl.

He was a graduate of Dover High School in 1961 and later served his country in the U S Navy from 1961 to 1964. He was a member of V.F.W. Post 5246 in Federalsburg.

He worked at Maryland Plastics in Federalsburg for 28 years retiring as traffic manager.

He is survived by his wife, Susan Ann Toomey Feyl, two daughters, Patricia Eigenbrode of Denton and Debra Brohawn of Federalsburg, a son, Michael A. 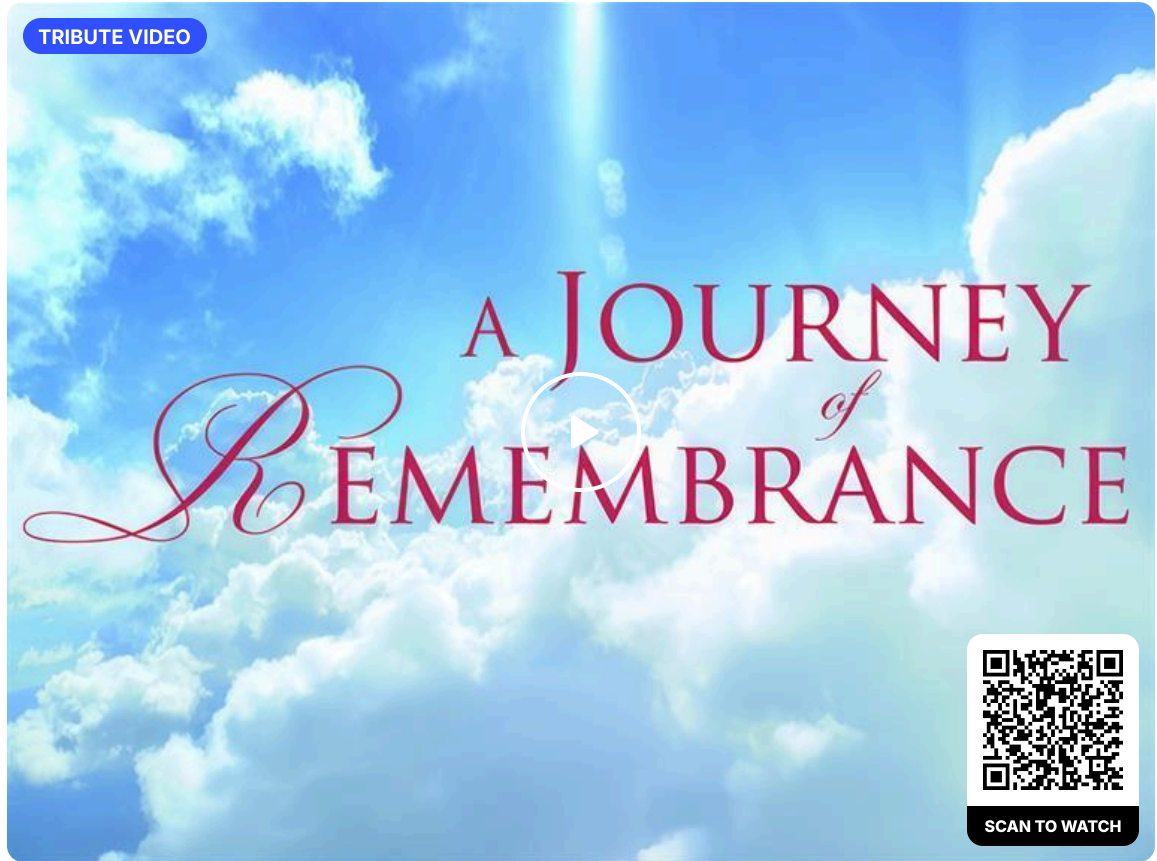
