**H**elen Mae Adams of Federalsburg passed away from heart failure on Tuesday, December 1, 2009, at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital in Seaford. She was 94.

She was born on April 15, 1915 in Concord, MD, the daughter of the late Alexander Lord and Sallie Collins Lord. She was preceded in death by her husband of almost 60 years, Reese LeRoy Adams on April 22, 1991.
