Elizabeth Ellwanger Towers of Denton, MD passed away on Wed. July 28, 2010 at Caroline Nursing Home in Denton. She was 93 years old.

She was born Jan. 3, 1917 in Greensboro, MD, the daughter of the late Freeborn B. and Isabelle B. Carrow Ellwanger. Her husband E. Grover Towers preceded her in death on Aug. 6, 1991.

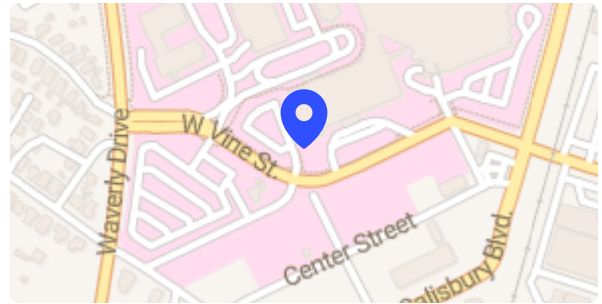
