Kathryn "Kay" Bee Cox of Federalsburg, MD passed away on Sat. Oct. 30, 2010 at Dorchester General Hospital in Cambridge, MD. She was 69 years old.

She was born May 5, 1941 in Easton, the daughter of the late Garcia H. and Dorothy Bradley Bee. She was a graduate of Federalsburg High School Class of 1959 and later attended Chesapeake College.
