Mary F. Zaffere Monroe of Easton, MD, formerly of Federalsburg, passed away peacefully in her sleep on Monday, April 4, 2011 at Genesis HealthCare-The Pines in Easton. She was 94.

Born March 11, 1917 in Millington, MD, she was the eldest daughter of the late Francis D. Zaffere and Anna Mabel Huhn Zaffere. Her husband of 50 years, Jack F. Monroe preceded her.

Mary attended elementary school at the former St. Gertrude's Academy in Ridgely, Md, and she graduated from Federalsburg High School and Goldey-Beacom College in Wilmington, DE. She worked for many years in the trucking industry, first at the former Service Trucking Company in Federalsburg, MD, and later at the former Preston Trucking Company in Preston, MD. She attended Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church in Seaford, DE for over 57 years.

She was preceded in death by a brother, Frank Zaffere.

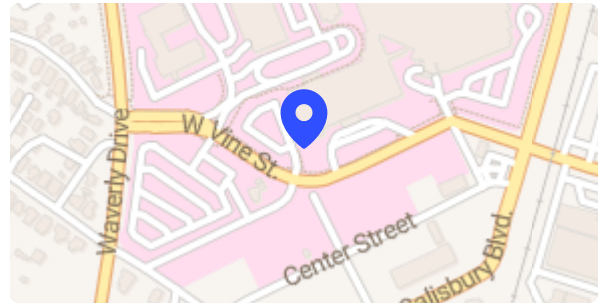
