**T**helma R. "Sue" Schmick died at Easton Memorial Hospital on Thursday, May 5, 2011. She was 78.

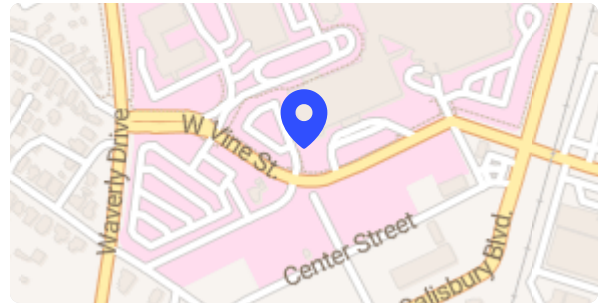

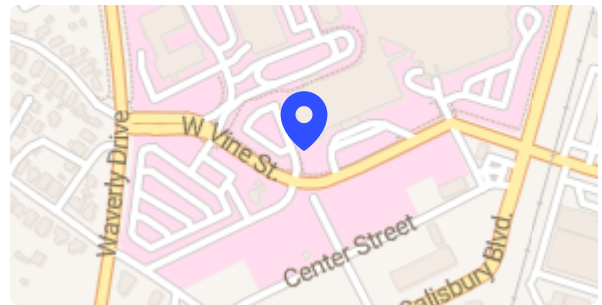

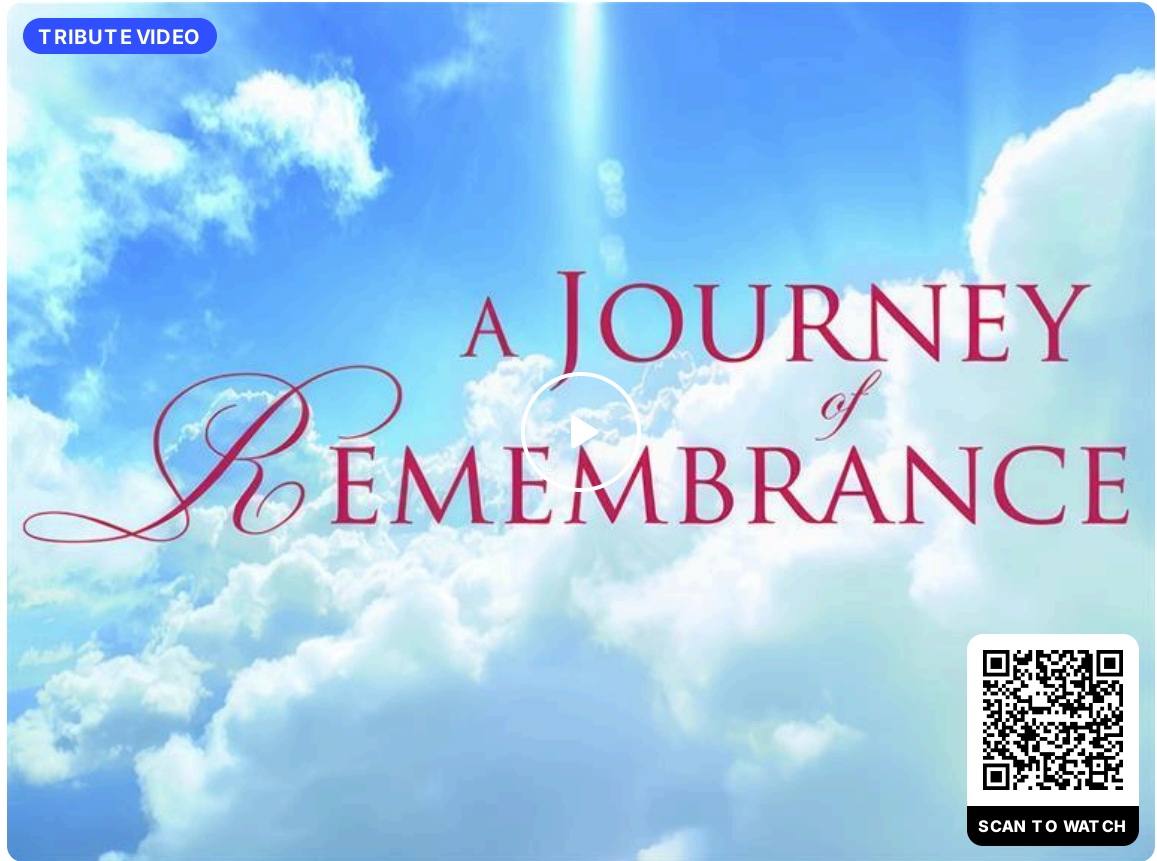
