**A**rchie Lacy Sinclair, Jr. passed away on Monday, June 6, 2011 at his home in Preston. He was 69.

He was born on April 3, 1942 in Cambridge, Maryland, the son of the late Archie L. Sinclair, Sr., and Anna Oneida Sinclair.

After graduating from High School, Archie enlisted in the United States Marine Corps in 1960 and was honorably discharged in 1963. After his service, he married the former Della Chance. 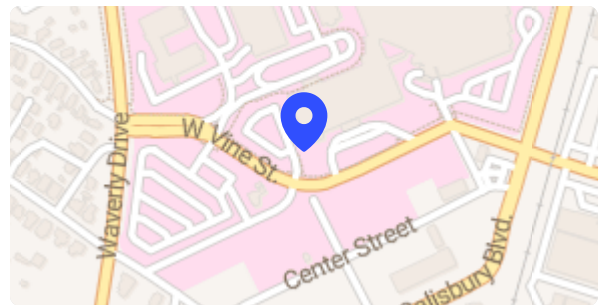
