Stanley F. Nimmo, formerly of River Road, Hurlock, passed away on Tuesday, Feb. 28, 2012 at the Gilchrist Hospice Center in Columbia, MD. He was 61.

He was born Jan. 17, 1951 in Easton, MD, son of the late Richard S. and Eleanor F. Nimmo. Stanley lived until 2005 on the Nimmo family farm, and was employed by the Delmarva Community Center in Cambridge. Stanley moved to Clarksville to live with his sister, Ruth, and was employed by The Arc of Howard County. He was active in Special Olympics and loved to travel.
