## Sharon Lynn Helgason

APR 8, 1957 - FEB 24, 2019

**S**haron “Lynn” Helgason passed away peacefully in Talbot Hospice with her family by her side on Sunday, February 24, 2019 in Easton, Maryland at the age of 61.

Lynn is survived by her former husband, Donald Helgason Jr., as well as her children, Donald Helgason III, Stacy Helgason, David Helgason, and her two grandchildren Tanner and Casey Helgason. She is preceded in death by both her parents, Richard and LaRue McNew and her daughter Molly Helgason.

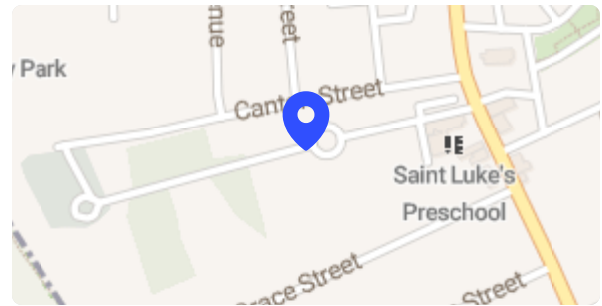

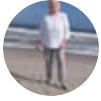
