**J**ames W. Lauck, Jr. “Mickey” passed away peacefully on Tuesday, December 24, 2019, surrounded by his family at the Hospice Center in Milford. He was 74.

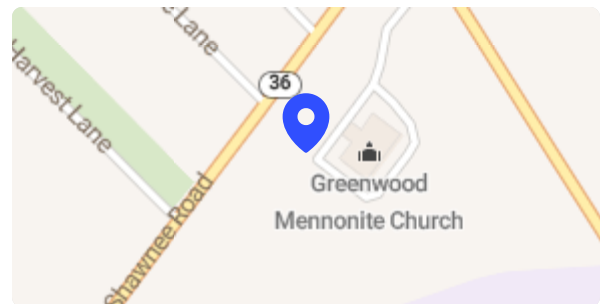

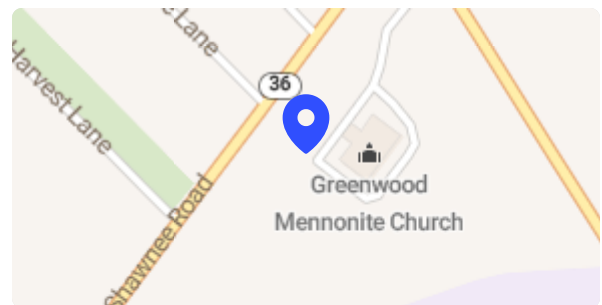

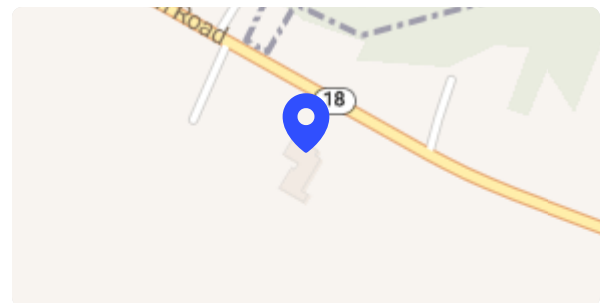
