He was born on September 7, 1933 in York, PA, the son of the late Elmer Cleveland Clouser, Sr., and Isabella Wilders Clouser.

After his education, he enlisted in the United States Army from 1956-1958. After he returned home, he worked as an electrical inspector.

He was a member of the Denton Post #29 American Legion, and the Democratic Club in Baltimore for many years.
