He was born on January 19, 1936 in Greenwood, DE, the son of the late Herman Smith Sr., and Mary Jenkins Smith

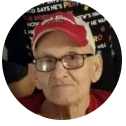
He married Ethel Moore Smith on April 23, 1952. She preceded him in death on December 19, 2015.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters: Elizabeth Johnson and Dorothy Harris and one brother, Leon Smith.

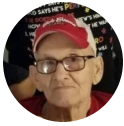

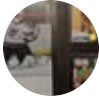
