**M**ary Lou Moore, formerly of Federalsburg, died Monday, Aug. 27, 2012 at Caroline Nursing Home in Denton, MD where she had been a patient for several years. She was 70.

She was born on March 1, 1942 in Bridgeville, DE the daughter of the late Earl P. Jester and Georgia Ann Scott Jester Willin. Her husband, James Franklin "Sleepy" Moore, Jr. preceded her in death as did a son, James F. Moore, III.
