John B Wagner, Jr. of Bethlehem, passed away on Saturday, December 19, 2020 at his home surrounded by his family. He was 80.

He was born on June 3, 1940 in Preston, Maryland, the son of the late John B. Wagner, Sr., and Virginia Andrews Wagner.

Growing up in Preston, John attended Preston School. He married June Hopkins Wagner on August 26, 1961 and they made their home in Bethlehem.

He worked for various manufacturing companies in Talbot and Caroline Counties. He retired from Food Instrument Corporation in Federalsburg to spend more time with his family and grandchildren.

John was known as “The Lawn Mower Man” of Bethlehem. He would sit on his mower waving to friends and neighbors on Bethlehem Road. He also enjoyed building and selling birdhouses for his family and friends. He attended Denton Wayside Church for many years.

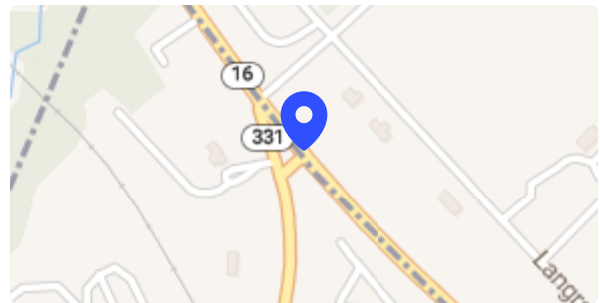
