Charles Griffith of Federalsburg passed away on Thursday, October 21, 2021 at Bay Health - Sussex Campus in Milford, DE. He was 84.

He was born on August 31, 1937 in Easton, Maryland, the son of the late Willy Dee Griffith.

"Charlie" graduated from North Dorchester High School with the class of 1954. He was married to Patricia Fisher Griffith. She preceded him in death on March 10, 2004.

He worked for E.I. DuPont in Seaford as a maintenance mechanic. He retired in 1992 with 37 years service.

Charlie was a member of the Park Lane Church of God in Federalsburg for many years. In his free time, he loved to barbecue, dining out with his family and friends, and spending time with his grandchildren. In his retirement, you could usually find Charlie at Marshy Hope Hardware having a coffee with the boys and sharing his wisdom. He loved to mow lawns for his close friends and especially widows of the community; never asking for anything in return. He was a kind man who would do anything for a stranger.
