Bryan F. Turbitt, Jr. of Federalsburg passed away on Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at Nanticoke Memorial Hospital in Seaford. He was 75.

He was born on October 22, 1946 in Ridgely, Maryland, the son of the late Bryan F. Turbitt, Sr., and Eleanor Greenhawk Turbitt.

He married Grace Eileen Matthews Turbitt and they made their home in Federalsburg. He worked as a truck driver for most of his career. He worked for Haines Holt in Federalsburg, Koski Trucking, and later for Blue Hen Lines. He later worked for DuPont in Seaford.

Bryan loved history and enjoyed reading war books. He was an Alabama football fan and also enjoyed spending time with his family and grandchildren.
