# Bette Rose Robinson

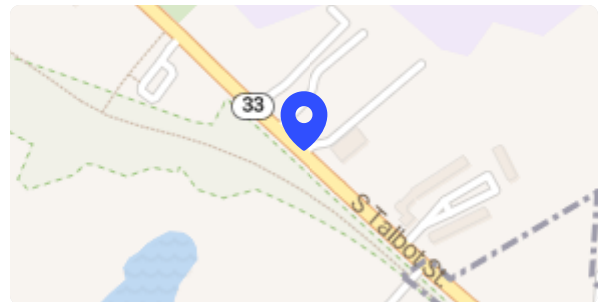
