Samuel "Duc" Young of Claymont DE, formerly of St. Michaels, died on Friday April 19, 2024 at the Temple University Hospital, Philadelphia. He was 63.

Born in Easton Maryland on December 23, 1960, he was the son of the late Sam Burton and Mildred Young. He graduated from St. Michaels in 1979 where he excelled in basketball and wrestling. While in High school he was a counselor at summer camp in St. Michaels. 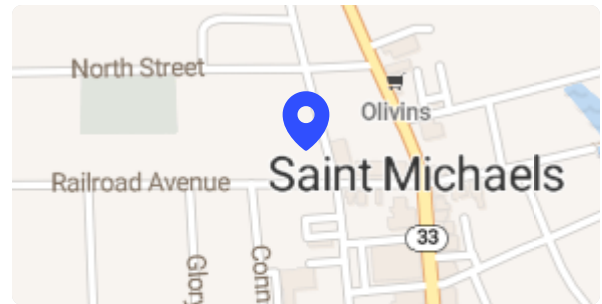

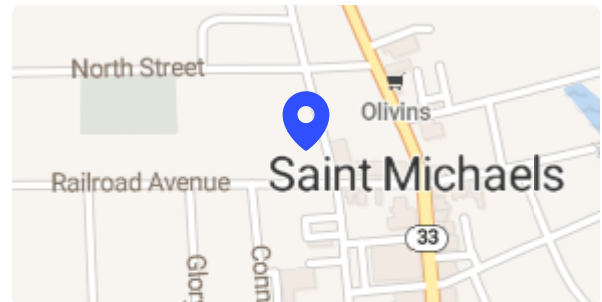
