William Edward Covey of Hurlock, MD passed away at his home on November 29, 2024. He was 81 years old.

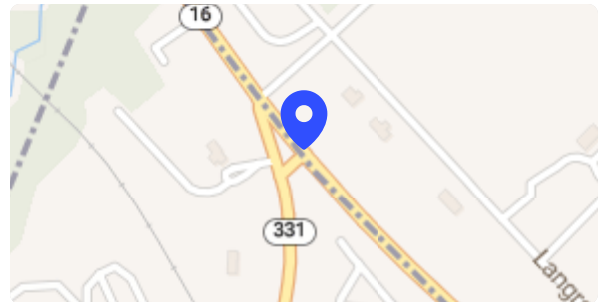
