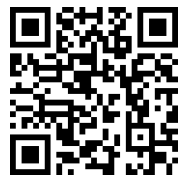

# Vernon Jay Schrock

Vernon Jay Schrock of Harrington passed away on Monday, December 15, 2025 at Tidal Health at Nanticoke in Seaford, DE. He was 69.

The service will be live streamed on YouTube at Greenwood Mennonite Church.



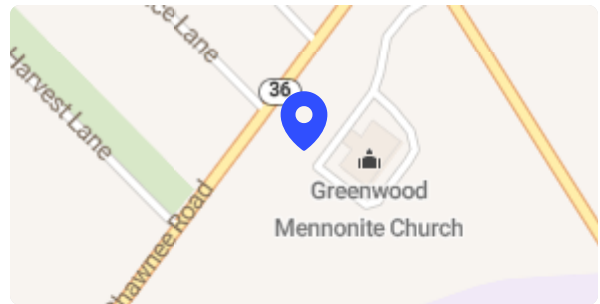
