Cynthia Ann Fellers Evey, lovingly known to all as Cindy, of Preston, MD passed away Thursday, September 17, 2015 at home in Preston, MD.

Born January 6, 1959 in Denver, CO, she was the daughter of the late Betty Dillow Fellers and Donald Fellers, Sr.

She was a graduate of Thomas Johnson High School in 1977 and Hood College, Frederick, MD in 1983 with a Bachelor's degree in Recreation Parks and Tourism Administration.

Cindy was recognized with accommodations in her field upon completion of her degree requirements.

Upon graduation, she was employed as a Recreation Supervisor at Caroline County Recreation and Parks for 16 years.


